CAREER AWARD

There is hereby established a Career Award conferring special recognition on career Environmental Health professionals who have distinguished themselves in their field. The following are guidelines for the nomination and selection of those individuals to be recognized:

A. General

- 1. Each calendar year, the Board, at its discretion may select up to two (2) individuals for special recognition for their contribution to the field of Environmental Health.**
- 2. Said award shall be presented by the Board in conjunction with the Nevada Environmental Health Association annual meeting.**

B. Nominations

- 1. Nominations for this award may be submitted to the Board by any Nevada-Registered Environmental Health Specialist.**
- 2. A nomination may not be made by a current Registration Board member.**
- 3. Nominations shall be submitted on forms provided by the Board for that purpose.**

C. Qualifications

- 1. The nominee shall have worked in an Environmental Health or related field for a minimum of twenty (20) years.**
- 2. The nominee must have been registered with the State of Nevada Board for Registration of Public Health Sanitarians or the Board of Registered Environmental Health Specialists for a minimum of five (5) years.**
- 3. The nominee shall , by his/her Environmental Health or related activities, have distinguished him/her-self as a leader in that field.**
- 4. The Board shall make final determination of eligibility, and shall choose recipients from among those individuals nominated.**
