The key issue at this session will be an amendment to enact mandatory registration of all Nevada environmentalists, as well as the “grandfathering” of currently non-registered environmentalists. The language drafted during this session will be presented to the 2005 Nevada State Legislative session via the Department of Administration. Bill language is to be submitted on or before May 1, 2004.
