The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the proposed draft regulations. The proposed regulation:

- clarifies requirements for establishing proof of compliance with fingerprinting;
- establishes a minimum period of 18 months of training prior to requesting approval to take the REHS examination;
- establishes the timeline for requesting authorization for re-take of the REHS examination if the trainee does not receive a passing score;

- updates the name of a training program approved by the board; and
- increases the fees charged by the Board for an initial standard or provisional registration and renewal of a standard and provisional registration.
